Saturday we will have the chance to discover the hidden beauties along the astonishing Appian Way (via Appia Antica). Starting from Circus Maximus (Circo Massimo) we walk 18km/11miles heading south up to Santa Maria delle Mole where we catch the train to come back to Rome.

Appian Way is a Roman road which was able to connect Rome to Brindisum (ancient Brindisi), one of the most important port in the ancient Italy for its commercial routes to Greece and middle East. Romans referred to this road as Regina Viarum (the Queen of the long roads) and is one of the largest and greatest engineering work of the ancient world, it had huge economic, military and cultural impact on roman society.

Nowadays it's till preserved, walkable and surrounded by many archeological sites.
